- i. Agreed the funding requests for NUSTEM and Digital Catapult proposals as part of the STEM and Digital Skills Programme as set out in section 1.2 of the report.
- ii. Agreed £455,626 to support the Newcastle Helix Incubator and Accelerator project.
- iii. Agreed a £618,472 allocation of the Inclusive Economy Innovation Fund to deliver a Returnships programme.
- iv. Authorised the Interim Head of Paid Service to finalise the conditions to be attached to the above funding awards and authorised the Interim Monitoring Officer to complete the necessary documentation.
- v. Agreed that the Combined Authority should proceed with the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) application as Accountable Body for the Urban Element of the North of Tyne Growth Fund.
- vi. Acknowledged ongoing development work on the Investment Fund, including development of the project pipeline, commissioned a feasibility study into a regional bank and endorsed the United Nations (UN) Climate Change Teacher Initiative.

5. Local Full Fibre Network	 i. Welcomed the award of £12m funding from the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS) for the Northumberland Gigabit Project. ii. Agreed that NTCA enter the Local Full Fibre Networks (LFFN) assurance process, including the provision of relevant procurement and Project information. iii. Authorised the Interim Head of Paid Service in consultation with the Monitoring Officer and the Head of Finance, to finalise, agree and execute (a) a grant agreement with DCMS for the receipt of the funding for the Northumberland Gigabit project and (b) an agreement with Northumberland County Council relating to the release and defrayal of that funding. iv.
