#### Reasons for the Decision(s)

In November 2018, the North of the Tyne Combined Authority (NTCA) Cabinet agreed that further development work should be undertaken on a STEM and Digital Skills Programme which would deliver school-based interventions that will inspire more young people to pursue STEM subjects and get involved in the development of coding skills.

On the 12<sup>th</sup> March 2019, the NTCA Cabinet approved a budget of up to £1,250,000 over 3 years for the STEM and Digital Skills Programme and authorised the Interim Head of Paid Service, in consultation with the Interim Mayor and portfolio holder for Education Improvement, to finalise and publish the call documentation.
