The Cabinet:

1. Approved the creation of a Citizens' Assembly to look at a specific set of issues relating to climate change that would produce actionable recommendations for the North of Tyne Combined Authority to consider.
2. Noted that the creation of a Citizens' Assembly would involve:
 - Recruitment of a 'deliberative democracy provider' – an external organisation to design and facilitate the Citizens' Assembly;
 - Establishment of an Oversight Panel to determine the topic and questions to be put to the Citizens' Assembly to consider;
 - Ensuring the inclusion of citizens from diverse backgrounds and cohorts.
3. Delegated the authority to finalise arrangements to the Head of Paid Service in consultation with the Investment Panel and Portfolio Holder (the Mayor), working within the budget envelope outlined in section 7.1 of the report (£80,000).
