	This delegated decision will approve and allocate funding from the Transforming Cities Fund Devolved Pot to the Durham City Active Mode Connectivity scheme, following successful appraisal in accordance with the Transport Assurance Framework.	
	In line with Recommendation i and iii of the Transforming Cities Fund Tranche 2 – Residual Grant Funding paper presented at the Joint Transport Committee meeting held on 18/07/2023, which recommended the release of up to £2,500,000 of residual TCF to the scheme and delegated authority to the Transport North East Managing Director, in consultation with the Section 73 Officer and Monitoring Officer, subject to successful appraisal of the scheme business case in line with the Transport Assurance Framework, to approve the scheme and enter into a Grant Funding Agreement with Durham County Council.
