Job Purpose

To support the implementation of strategies for all aspects of the Transport Programmes function for the North East Combined Authority (North East CA). Overseeing specific service areas, ensuring effective implementation management of day-to-day business operations providing support across the organisation to wider operational delivery of the North East CA's objectives.

This role requires someone with ability to manage vertically and horizontally across the organisation to ensure the service area is effective and efficient. This role requires strong leadership capability and a good understanding of transport policy, infrastructure delivery, funding mechanisms, and the wider economic, social and environmental context in which transport investment decisions are made for the North East to effectively secure and manage funding that drives regional growth and competitiveness.

The successful candidate is someone who can provide strategic direction, build strong partnerships with stakeholders and drive the development and delivery of investment programmes that support sustainable growth and connectivity across the region.

Duties and responsibilities

Leadership and Innovation

You will be responsible for supporting the implementation of strategies in relation to transport
programmes of the North East CA which are fully aligned to our Corporate Plan, strategic
policy priorities and Organisational values.

- You will be part of the Authority's management team and work directly to the Assistant Director of Transport Programmes and Investment Planning providing subject matter expertise.
- You will provide a leadership role for the transport programmes team ensuring measurable delivery against a set of clear objectives.
- You will work across the North East CA to provide strategic advice on all aspect of transport
 programmes work from policy development through to operational delivery, gaining a close
 understanding of the Directorates and their operational requirements.
- You will be able to use insight and evaluation to challenge established practices and introduce ongoing service improvements.

Impact on People – (Internal and External Influencing)

- In supporting the development of strategies for transport programmes you will develop positive relationships with a broad range of internal stakeholders, building and maintaining strong collaborative partnerships. Externally you will be expected to build relationships across our local authority community as well as other combined authorities and government departments.
- You will be responsible for all aspects of stakeholder engagement for the North East CA.

Financial Resource Management:

- This role is responsible for overseeing the resources (financial and non-financial) allocated to the transport programmes function of the Authority, ensuring that this is managed to achieve effective value for money and clear allocation of resources to deliver against strategic objectives.
- You will lead your team, creating a high-performance culture that is aligned to organisational values, behaviours, policy vision and priorities, reflecting best practice and continuous professional development.
- You will ensure that the team is supported and developed throughout.

Role Responsibilities:

- Lead the ongoing development and management of the North East CA Transport Capital Programme with the aim of securing increased investment in the regions transport infrastructure and services.
- Responsibility for the delivery and day to day management of devolved transport funding within the region.
- Prepare, agree, and manage robust and cost-effective budgets as required.
- Develop and assess business cases for investment of local and national funding, including supporting and advising scheme promoters on the development and delivery of their business cases.
- Lead the development of high quality, compelling bids and business cases that respond to
 future opportunities to attract capital and revenue investment into the region, meeting all
 aspects of Government guidance and complying with necessary timescales.

- Monitor the emergence of future funding opportunities for the region. Influence DfT, HM
 Treasury and other key funding stakeholders in Government to prepare guidance for funding
 bids that matches the transport needs of the North East region.
- Develop, manage, and maintain the North East Local Transport Plan Delivery Plan Pipeline of schemes supporting the delivery of the Mayor's Transport Plan.
- Contribute to the development, management and maintenance of Single Assurance
 Framework as it relates to transport, ensure scheme compliance, and advise scheme promoters on the processes outlined within the Single Assurance Framework.
- To act as key adviser to the Mayor, Cabinet, Finance and Investment Board, and other
 decision-making groups in relation to the delivery of the Single Assurance Framework as it
 relates to transport. Including advising on the recommended actions and approvals associated
 with investment proposals.
- Work closely with the seven Local Authorities and Nexus on the development and monitoring
 of transport schemes, ensuring the integration and alignment of investment against agreed
 priorities, including the objectives and requirements of devolved funding programmes and the
 North East Local Transport Plan, through regular progress meetings with individual scheme
 promoters and region-wide discussion and decision-making groups.
- Manage the process of assembling, recruiting, and commissioning the necessary resources to develop high quality bids, including programme management, stakeholder engagement and business case development resources.
- Develop a suite of technical and specialist documents that support the development of the capital programme, schemes, and bidding opportunities.
- Managing consultancy support contracts and procurement exercises in support of the delivery
 of programmes, schemes and assurance functions.
- Ensure that the delivery of the transport capital programme and all schemes within utilise sound programme and project management methodology, ensure that key risks are identified, mitigated and managed.
- Act as an ambassador promoting the interests of the region. Plan and lead high level meetings with DfT officials, senior officers from the seven North east local authorities, relevant neighbouring authorities and other regional transport stakeholders.
- Ensure that appropriate reporting is put in place and maintained including the evaluation and monitoring of schemes and programmes.

Other Key Activities

- Lead and motivate the individuals working with the postholder, to deliver the appropriate objectives.
- Develop, maintain and manage relationships with the Department for Transport (DfT) and other key stakeholders.

- Plan and lead high level meetings with DfT officials, senior officers from the seven North east local authorities, relevant neighbouring authorities and other regional transport stakeholders.
- Oversee procurement exercises and manage contracts with external suppliers, as and when necessary.
- Deputise for the Assistant Director of Transport Programmes and Investment Planning as required.
- Lead the production of timely and informed briefing notes and reports for internal and external stakeholders, including the Mayor, the Cabinet portfolio holder for transport, Transport Advisory Board and MPs.
- Verbally present reports and deliver presentations to the Senior Leadership Team, Heads of Transport meeting, Economic Directors, and other officer groups as required.
- Represent the North East CA at local, regional and national meetings and events.

Organisational responsibilities

Communication

We communicate effectively with our peers, partners and local authorities and work collaboratively to provide the best possible outcomes. Communication between teams, services and partner organisations is imperative in providing the best possible service to the region.

Confidentiality
