Approved freezing the price of single and daily capped fares on both Metro and Ferry for young people aged 18 and under, bought with a Pop blue smartcard.

The retention of the 60% discount on Metro season tickets for young people aged 18 and under, compared to the equivalent adult Metro season ticket price

The retention of a similar 30% discount on Metro student season tickets be approved.

The retention of the Corporate Metro Season ticket scheme, offering discounts for tickets purchased through an employer and easy monthly payments for customers be approved.

Reducing the price of Ferry season tickets to encourage take up amongst regular travellers be approved.
